MAPPING SUB-COMMITTEE (MTBO)

TERMS OF REFERENCE

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. The scope of roles and responsibilities is for MTBO events.
- 2. The MTBO Mapping Sub-Committee is responsible for;
 - a) Determining the requirements for new and upgraded maps for events that will be conducted by OACT.
 - b) Overseeing the mapping projects, with emphasis on priority projects associated with major Carnivals.
 - c) Managing the cost of mapping, and approving the payment for mapping within the financial delegations given by the Board to the MTBO Mapping Sub-Committee.
- 3. The MTBO Mapping Sub-Committee is accountable to the OACT Board, and is to provide an update at every second Board Meeting, or as requested by the President.

MEMBERSHIP AND MEETINGS

- 4. The OACT Board appoints members to the MTBO Mapping Sub-Committee and must review membership of the Sub-Committee at least once every two years.
- 5. It is desirable, although not essential, that the MTBO Mapping Sub-Committee includes at least one member who is also a member of the OACT Board.
- 6. On occasions when the Orienteering Australia Technical Committee has listed MTBO mapping items for discussion on their meeting agenda, at least one member of the OACT MTBO Mapping Sub-Committee should attend or be represented at that meeting.

DELEGATIONS

- 7. The MTBO Mapping Sub-Committee is delegated to spend up to \$1,500 over a three year period on mapping projects. Nominally, this is \$500 per year, with any unspent funds carrying forward into the next year.
- 8. Mapping projects that are 100% cost recoverable (and those costs are in fact recovered) within the current OACT Financial Year, or where the mapping is part of a fully externally funded activity or project (such as through the Commonwealth Government's Sporting

- Schools grants program), do not need to be included under the \$500 nominal annual allocation.
- 9. The MTBO Mapping Sub-Committee can seek approval from the OACT Board for additional funding where the cost of mapping is included in the budget for a major Carnival and will be recovered, at no less than 80% of cost, through income obtained from the Carnival.
- 10. The OACT Treasurer is to obtain approval in writing from the MTBO Mapping Sub-Committee before payment of claims for mapping projects.

EXCLUSIONS

11. The MTBO Mapping Sub-Committee will not be responsible for management of mapping for Foot-O, Street-O or Ski-O events.
